English Activities

1. Tudor Diary Entry

Write a diary entry as if you are a servant in Henry VIII's palace. Describe what you saw, heard, and did during a royal feast.

2. Create a Tudor Newspaper Report

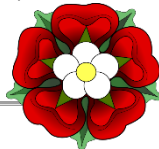
Write a news article announcing one of Henry VIII's marriages or the sinking of the Mary Rose.

3. Tudor Character Profile

Choose a famous Tudor (e.g., Elizabeth I, Anne Boleyn, Francis Drake). Write a factfile including appearance, personality, achievements, and one surprising fact.

4. Write a Tudor Poem

Create a poem about life in Tudor times—perhaps a rhyming poem about a royal banquet or a day in a village.



Maths Activities

5. Tudor Shopping Challenge

Imagine you're shopping in a Tudor market. Create a price list for bread, candles, meat, fabric etc. Then set 5 maths problems (addition, subtraction, multiplication) using your prices.

6. Tudor Timeline Maths

Create a timeline of Tudor monarchs and calculate:

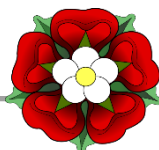
- How long each monarch ruled
- The difference between reign lengths

7. Symmetrical Tudor Roses

Draw Tudor roses and identify lines of symmetry. Try to make increasingly complex versions.

8. Tudor Architecture Angles Hunt

Look at pictures of Tudor houses (or buildings nearby). Sketch one and label **right**, **acute**, and **obtuse** angles.



Art & Design Activities

9. Draw or Paint a Tudor Portrait

Copy a Tudor-style portrait (like Henry VIII or Elizabeth I). Focus on clothing, patterns, and poses.

10. Build a Tudor House Model

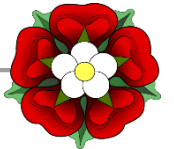
Use cardboard, sticks, or recycled materials to create a Tudor house with timber-framed walls.

11. Make a Tudor Rose

Create a 2D or 3D Tudor Rose using paper, clay, or play-dough.

12. Design Tudor Clothing

Sketch an outfit for a Tudor king, queen, noble or servant. Label fabrics, colours, and accessories.



History Activities

13. Tudor Family Tree

Create a family tree showing the Tudor monarchs from Henry VII to Elizabeth I.

14. Research a Tudor Explorer

Choose an explorer such as Sir Francis Drake or John Cabot. Present your findings as a poster or fact page.

15. Compare Tudor Life With Today

Make a table comparing food, transport, houses, school and jobs in Tudor times vs modern life.

16. What Was the Mary Rose?

Research the Mary Rose and create:

- a labelled diagram, or
- a short explanation of why it sank.
