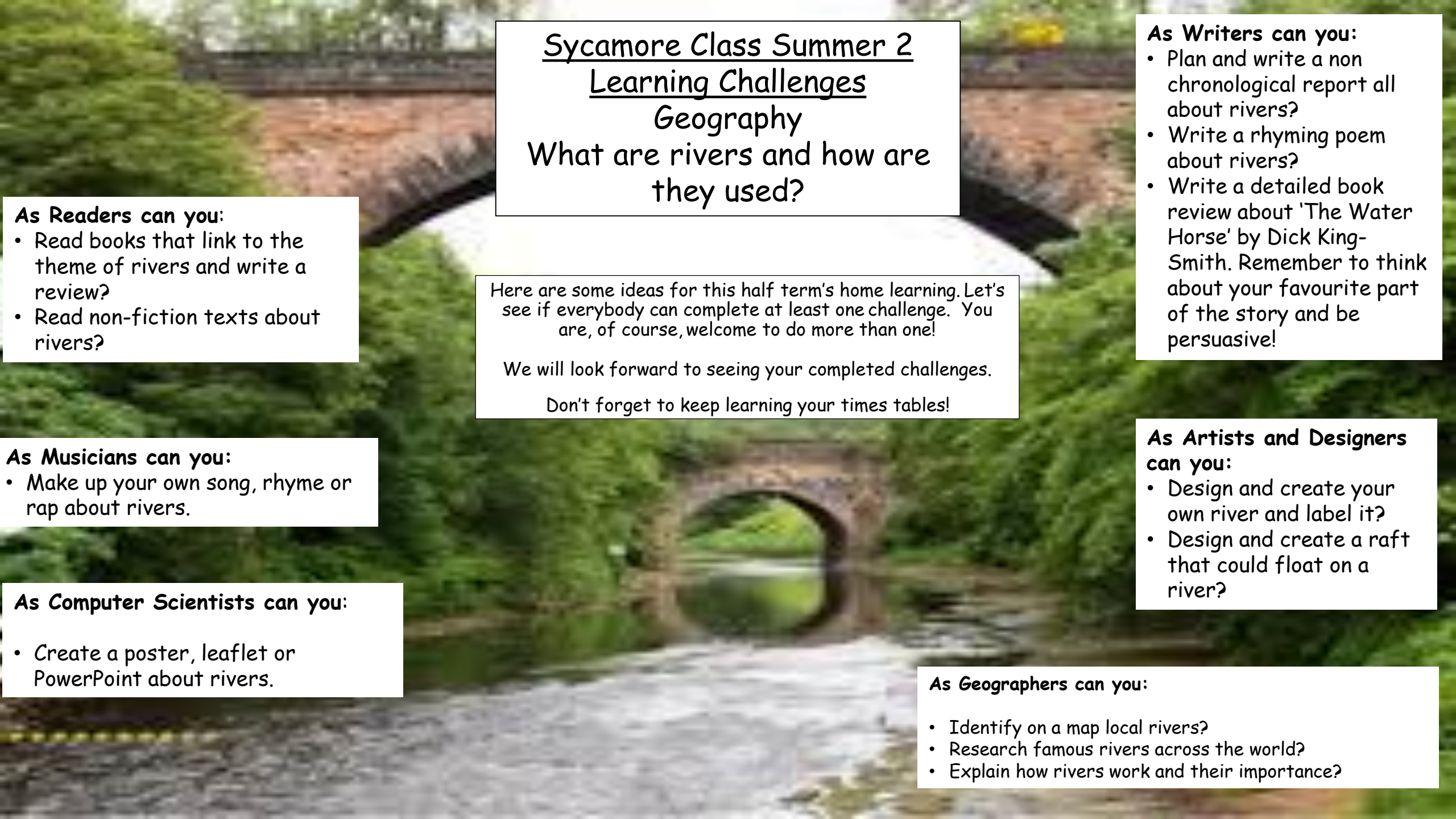




Sycamore Class Summer 2 Learning Challenges Geography What are rivers and how are they used?
