As Musicians you could:

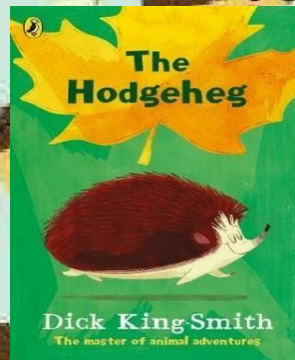
Make up a rap, rhyme or song about animals or the human body.
