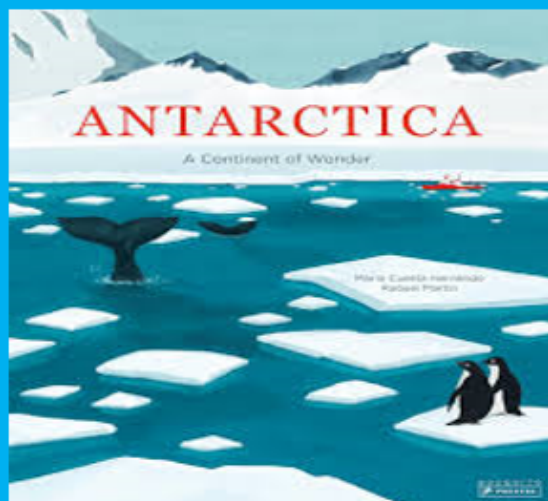


As Historians you could:
