Listening, attention and understanding

I can listen carefully.

I can retell simple stories.

Word reading

Writing

I can write tricky words.
I can write simple sentences.

Gross motor

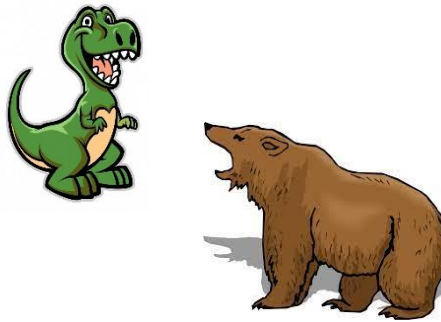
I can throw, kick, pass and catch a large ball.
